The Economic Development, Investment, Trade and Natural Resources is seeking a qualified individual to fill the position of Provincial Fire Training and Development Supervisor in Winnipeg.

- Strong verbal communication skills including effective presentation skills.
- Excellent leadership skills including the demonstrated ability to mentor, coach and provide guidance.
- Ability to work independently with strong organizational and time management skills.
- Strong written communication skills.
- Demonstrated experience working with Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Outlook, Access) or similar computer applications.

# **Desired:**

#### **Duties:**

This position is responsible to coordinate and provide expertise in the delivery of the Fire Program's training and development services. Other duties and responsibilities include: developing, implementing and supporting technical and operational training, and the development of standards and specifications. This position also involves researching, designing, writing, publishing and evaluating a variety of training and safety materials as well as, coordinating, scheduling, and at times facilitating training courses.

Specifically, this position coordinates the provincial Qualifications and Certification Program and manages a provincial training and certification database using established technologies. In addition, this position oversees all provincial fire management training, training related projects, and manages contractors. The incumbent chairs the Provincial Training Working Group and may represent Manitoba on the National Training Working Group and the Great Lakes Forest Fire Compact Training Working Team. This position also fullfills roles in the Provincial Fire Centre and various roles on fire action across the province when required during the operational wildfire season.
